



Hello Ladies,

Thanks for submitting your registration forms indicating your interest in participating in Ladies Night. We had 45 ladies submit registration forms with the majority indicating they prefer to participate in a ladies night. We had 4 groups interested in a League format so I will look at potentially setting up some competitive matches for those groups later on.

With the Ladies Night format, we do not require a commitment of weekly play but do ask that you call the proshop before 10:00 a.m. the day of play to register. We also had quite a few Ladies without partners, so you can register with your partner, as a single and we will pair you up or mix it up and bring someone new. Overall if you are playing in Ladies Night it is open to any ladies, registered or not. I am missing a few emails, please ensure that your partner or friends receive this email and as them to let us know so that we can add them to our list.

As mentioned in the previous email, Tétrault Wealth Management will be sponsoring Ladies Night. Every week we will give away \$45.00 (3 x \$15.00 gift certificates). **Important Reminder on the Key COVID rules to follow at the course:**

As I'm sure you all know, we have some pretty strict Public Health Orders currently. We will be following and enforcing the new Public Health Orders. Whether you agree or disagree with these orders, one thing is clear to me, we aren't allowed to do much, but we are allowed to golf. With that being said, we will be monitored closely by our health inspector. He's been in communication with me a few times regarding the importance of following these Health Orders. I'm asking all of you to please respect the rules while you are here so that we can remain open and not get fined. Everyone seems to have a different level of comfort or concern with the risks, so please take that into consideration as well. We want everyone to feel safe while they are here playing golf and having fun socializing while respecting physical distancing. Currently Golf is seen as a sport that can be played safely during this pandemic and we can keep it that way if we all do our part and respect the rules.

- Wear a mask inside the clubhouse
- Always maintain physical distancing of 6ft inside or outside the clubhouse
- Alcohol is allowed on the course without food. (we will have 2 beverage carts on the course)
- Alcohol is allowed in the Restaurant and Patio (outside seating) but you must order food.
- Inside the restaurant, you can only sit at the same table as someone from the same residence, so we are encouraging the majority of you to use the outside seating area as much as possible.
- Outside on the patio or outdoor seating area, we can have a maximum of 4 people per table from any residence. This also means we can have 2 people sharing 1 cart.

- Maximum of 10 people gathering outside in one area. We have a lot of open space outside, so we will set up tables and chairs to respect these rules. Please do not move the tables or chairs and ensure you're not gathering in a group larger than 10.
- No rakes on the course. (if you land in a sand trap you may lift your ball, smooth over the sand with your foot and place the ball back in its original spot to shoot)
- Leave the flagsticks in the cup.
- Have fun and stay safe!

Our league has always been about having fun first and foremost and not about stressing over the little things. If you're not sure of a rule please ask your opposition for help, if they aren't sure you can come to a friendly agreement or you can ask Mitch for clarification following your round.
